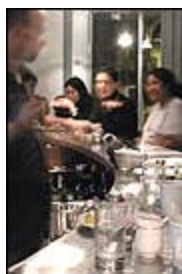

A good fisherman knows the value of patience, and so do the patrons of Mary's Fish Camp: They line up outside at least 30 minutes before the doors open in anticipation of the exemplary seafood within. Mary Redding, former partner at Pearl Oyster Bar, is the solo force behind the West Village eatery, which is named after a campground in Florida. Although the bare-bones, shanty interior is ultracasual, the food is a cut above. Redding puts her unique spin on such standbys as New England clam chowder and fried oysters, and goes beyond the ordinary with entrees like lobster pot pie and whole fried black sea bass. Mary's doesn't take reservations, so get there early, grab a seat at the curved brushed-steel bar and let your tastebuds go for a swim. -- *Leslie Rosenberg*
